

Dear Friends,

With 2020 now behind us, we are better able to reflect on a year that challenged all of us in new and unimaginable ways.

Traditionally the Foundation's efforts focused on children learning the basics of water safety and supporting the National Team athletes on the world stage.

But last year the world changed, and we had to change along with it. For us, hindsight truly became 2020 as the Foundation broadened its focus to include providing grants to local clubs in need and supporting efforts to open our sport to more people than ever.

New needs in our swimming community came to the forefront during the COVID-19 pandemic and the Foundation answered the call, providing more than \$3 million in COVID relief grants to more than 700 USA Swimming member clubs.

The Foundation staff and the structure of our Board of Directors changed as well. Four pillars of engagement were created to support the Foundation's work: Generate Revenue, Make a Difference in Communities, Engage Alumni, and Support Facilities & Pools. Each of these represent a focal point of support for our efforts, and each one is led by an executive USA Swimming staff member and supported by the members of the Foundation Board of Directors.

And we could not have accomplished any of this without your continued investment in the sport of swimming. In 2020, we were also able to provide:

- More than \$970,000 in Saving Lives programing support, and of that, \$314,114 in direct grants to learn-to-swim providers who provide the lifesaving gift of swim lessons.
- More than \$822,000 in grants were awarded to the National Team, including National Team athlete and coach support as they pursued their dreams of representing Team USA in Tokyo, Japan this year.

Your support continues to help us save lives, build champions and serve even more of the swimming community. We have already started 2021 off strong, including developing a partnership with U.S. Masters Swimming to support learn-to-swim programs for swimmers of all ages.

And this is just the beginning.

The document that follows details the impact of your gifts to the USA Swimming Foundation on the people and programs they supported in this trying year. Your contributions were more important than ever, and we cannot thank you enough for sticking with us through this difficult time.

From all of us at the USA Swimming Foundation and USA Swimming, we wish you a happy, healthy, and hopeful 2021.






Statement of Activities

TOTAL \$4,419,415




